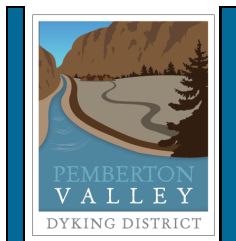

- Voter Eligibility: (ID must be presented) Only persons attending the election and meeting the following eligibility requirements are entitled to vote:**
- A Canadian citizen
 - Eighteen years of age, or older
 - An owner of land in the improvement district
 - A resident of the province for the prior six months
 - One vote is allowed for a person who is a legal representative of an owner of land in the improvement district who has died, become insolvent or insane.
 - One vote is also allowed for each board or corporation that owns land within the improvement district. The board or corporation must designate one person to act as an authorized agent to vote on its behalf. This must be delivered in writing on company letterhead before the election begins. If voting on behalf of a board or corporation a Statutory Declaration must also be signed.
 - If more than one person is registered on title as a landowner, each one can vote as long as they also meet the other qualifications. However, no person can have two votes unless they meet the qualifications to be an elector and are also an agent authorized to vote on behalf of a board or corporation.



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
